



## **Peterborough Cathedral Chapter**

### **Criteria for Marrying in the Cathedral**

The Faculty Office of the Archbishop of Canterbury has confirmed the criteria which will be accepted for the issuing of Special Licences for Marriage in a letter dated 4<sup>th</sup> September 2017. These are as follows:

- Current and former Members of Chapter and children of these.
- Those whose names are entered on the Cathedral Roll and children of these. Eligibility for this is that the person concerned must attend Cathedral Services a minimum of once a month for a continuous period of six months (not just six times). Any service counts.
- Clergy who would otherwise be eligible to be on the Cathedral Roll and children of these.
- Current members of Staff of the Cathedral and former members of staff who have given substantial service in the past (defined as at least ten years), and children of these.
- Residents of the Cathedral Precincts – by Banns of Marriage, not Special Licence.
- Former choristers of the Cathedral.
- Current and former students of The King's (The Cathedral) School.
- Current members of staff (teaching and non-teaching) of The King's (The Cathedral) School and former members of staff who have given substantial service in the past (defined as at least ten years).
- Exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis.
