FAITH IN STONE

Peterborough Cathedral has stood here for almost 1,400 years as a witness of God's love and as an expression of faith in stone. The Saxon King Peada founded the first monastery here in 655 AD. It was rebuilt several times over the next 500 years after destruction by Viking raids or fire, but was finally built in its present form between 1118 and 1238. During the reformation the monastery was dissolved, but the abbey church became the Cathedral of the new Diocese of Peterborough.

Katharine of Aragon and Mary Queen of Scots were buried here, although Mary's body was moved to Westminster Abbey by her son. In the Civil War much damage was done to the Cathedral by Cromwell's troops. The choir stalls, bishop's throne, marble floor and high altar were all created by the Victorian architect Pearson in the 19th century after the tower had to be re-built. Since the disastrous fire of November 2001 a massive cleaning and restoration programme has been undertaken, but there is still an expensive and endless task remaining to maintain the building and fulfil its purpose.
