How you can make a difference

Leaving a gift at the end of your life to a place that has inspired or sustained you is a remarkable way to ensure that those who follow in your footsteps can enjoy the same experiences. Each year around one hundred thousand people come to Peterborough Cathedral to worship or encounter the treasures and history it holds. This includes thousands of schoolchildren visiting our state-of-the-art education rooms to learn about

the Cathedral and its religious, cultural and historic significance. Throughout the year, we offer events, learning opportunities and exhibitions for all ages, such as during the Katharine of Aragon Festival. By creating lasting memories for local communities, we encourage them to return to this special place again and again.

General funds

It costs around £6,000 per day to run Peterborough Cathedral; a legacy gift towards the Cathedral's general funds is especially valuable as it gives us the freedom to allocate the money to the area of highest need at the time the gift is received.

However, you may wish to support a specific area of Cathedral life which is close to your heart, such as:

Fabric

The Cathedral building, furnishings and precincts are in need of constant care and attention. Our building inspection report recommends spending at least £700k each year on essential repairs and restoration. Additionally we have a future vision, known as 'Living Stones', for buildings and walkways in our precincts. By leaving a legacy gift you can be part of conserving our buildings and treasures of national and international significance for generations to come.

Ministry

Peterborough Cathedral is first and foremost a place of worship. The Cathedral was built to give glory to God and that priority continues to inspire the rhythm of daily prayer, praise and music. The rich variety of worship here marks key moments in the life of the city, the diocese, the nation and the individual. By leaving a gift to the worship and mission, you will be helping to sustain the Cathedral's long tradition of serving as a beacon to the glory of God.

Music

Music and the great English Choral Tradition is at the heart of Cathedral life. The Cathedral Choir provides a remarkable educational opportunity for the 50 local young people who serve as choristers. The opportunity to audition for the Cathedral Choir is open to any child, regardless of their background. A gift to this area will not only sustain Cathedral music; it will give talented young people the opportunity to experience a world-class musical education.

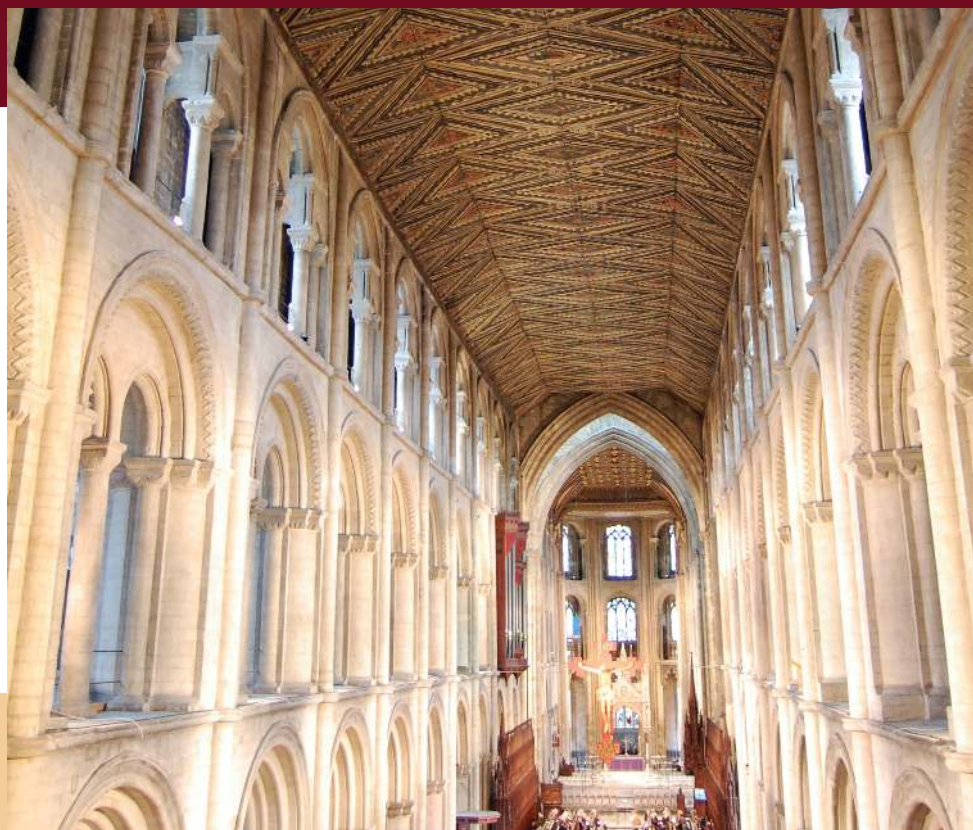
